## Introduction

The Global Partnership for Education Fund (GPEF) was established as a Financial Intermediary Fund in 2011 as part of the rebranding process of the Education for All-Fast Track Initiative (EFA-FTI), which started in 2002. The World Bank acts as the Trustee for the GPEF.

The Trustee provides administrative and financial services to the GPE Board and Contributors by receiving contributions from Contributors, investing liquid assets pending cash transfer, and transferring funds to Grant Agents. Working closely with the GPE Secretariat, the Trustee also records funding decisions made by the GPE Board.

The Trustee is required to provide periodic reports to the Board on the financial status of the Trust Fund<sup>1</sup>. This report is prepared based on financial information as of March 31, 2020.

## GPEF Trust Fund Financial Summary as of March 31, 2020

#### Contributions:

Each Contributor enters into a Contribution Agreement or Arrangement with the Trustee to make a contribution to the GPEF. As of March 31, 2020, the Trustee had entered into Contribution Agreements/Arrangements with 27 Contributors for a total of <u>USD eq. 4,479.8 million</u> in contributions, of which the Trustee has received <u>USD eq. 3,970.3 million</u> in cash from these Contributors.

#### Investment Income:

As of March 31, 2020, the GPEF Trust Fund earned investment income of approximately <u>USD 81.1 million</u> on the undisbursed balance of the Trust Fund. The GPEF Trust Fund portfolio has returned 0.99% through the calendar year to March 31, 2020.

### **Funding Approvals:**

The cumulative funding decisions made by the GPE Board through March 31, 2020 totaled <u>USD 4,101.7 million</u>. Of the total amount approved, USD 3,391.3 million represents Program Implementation Grant approvals. The Trustee has committed a total of USD 3,279.2 million based on the instruction from the GPE Secretariat.

### Cash Transfers:

Based on GPE Board funding decisions and in accordance with the terms of the Financial Procedures Agreements between the Trustee and the Grant Agents, the Trustee has transferred a total of <u>USD 3,168.3 million</u> up to March 31, 2020, of which USD 2,831.9 million was for projects that include Program Implementation Grants, Program Development Grants, Multiplier, Knowledge and Innovation Exchange, Global and Regional activities, Education Plan Development Grants, Civil Society Education Fund, Better Early Learning and Development at Scale, Advocacy and Social Accountability, Assessment for Learning, Gender Responsive Education Sector Planning and Country Level Admin.

#### Funds Held in Trust and Funds Available for GPE Board Funding Decisions:

**Funds Held in Trust** reflects contributions paid-in from Contributors, investment income, and net cash transfers. Funds Held in Trust as of March 31, 2020 amounted to <u>USD 883.1 million</u>.

*Funds available* for the Trustee's commitment amounted to USD 773.0 million as of March 31, 2020, a decrease of USD 38.4 million compared to December 31, 2019.

- As of March 31, 2020, the Trustee had entered into Contribution Agreements or Arrangements with 27 Contributors for a total amount of USD eq. 4,479.8 million, an increase of USD eq. 7.8 million since December 31, 2019. The contributors which accounted for the net increase were Denmark (DKK 300.0 million), France (EUR 1.0 million) and Japan (USD 0.8 million).
- The Trustee received a total of USD 3,970.3 million in cash from these Contributors, an increase of USD eq. 75.3 million since December 31, 2019. The increase was due to the contributions received from Australia (AUD 30.0 million) Canada (CAD 60.0 million), Japan (USD 0.8 million), and Switzerland (CHF 10.0 million).
- Contributions receivable from the signed Contribution Agreements or Arrangements amounts to USD eq. 509.6 million on the basis of exchange rates as of March 31, 2020.




## 3. Asset Mix and Investment Income

#### **ASSET MIX**

Funds held in trust by the World Bank (as the Trustee) are maintained in a commingled investment portfolio (the "Pool") for all trust funds administered by the World Bank.

The World Bank employs the Conditional Value-at-Risk (CVaR) measure as the risk constraint in the management of trust funds. GPEF funds are managed such that the expected maximum loss, as measured by the CVaR, at the portfolio's investment horizon, is not to exceed 1% with 99% confidence.






#### **INVESTMENT INCOME**

GPEF funds are invested in a short and medium horizon portfolio of the World Bank's trust fund investment pool. This portfolio comprises investments in government bonds and money markets with an investment horizon of up to three years. The GPEF Trust Fund liquid portfolio (which totaled approximately USD 883.1 million at end-March 2020) has returned 0.99% through the calendar year to March 31, 2020 and earned approximately USD 81.1 million in investment income since inception.

GPEF funds may include an allocation to developed market equities from Q1 FY21, as approved by the GPE Board at the GPE Board meeting in June 2018.

### **Funding Decisions by Activity**


The cumulative funding decisions made by the GPE Board up to March 31, 2020 amount to USD 4,101.7 million. Of these decisions, 82.7% went to Program Implementation Grants, 1.3% to Civil Society Education Fund, 2.5% to Agency Fees, 5.4% to Administrative Budget, 1.3% to Advocacy and Social Accountability, 1.6% to Knowledge and Innovation Exchange, 1.0% to Supervision Allocations, 2.2% to Multiplier and less than 1% each to Education Plan Development Grants, Global and Regional Activities, Program Development Grants, Assessment for Learning, Better Early Learning & Development at Scale, Gender Responsive Education Sector Planning and Country Level Admin.


# Funding Decisions by Agent (Program Implementation Grant)


The pie chart shows the breakdown of the cumulative program implementation grant approvals by Grant Agent.
