a/ Per Clause 2.1.3 of Canada's Grant Agreement, a part of Canada's contribution (the "Initial Funds") is not available for AMC disbursement until annual maximum cumulative contributions ("Subsequent Funds") have been disbursed. With payment of USD 10.16 million in 2014, Canada's payment reached the limit established for the year ending June 30, 2015 of USD 94.7 million (per Schedule 4 of Canada's Grant Agreement). The remaining amount of Canada's share (USD 87.6 million) was drawdown from the total initial funds of USD 105.3 million. The remaining amount of Initial Funds not available for AMC disbursements is USD 17.7 million.
